Regularly Scheduled Events

Adult Coloring Night – A proven stress reliever and a great way to spend an hour and a half after work. Bring your own materials or use our colored pencils and designs. For ages 18 and up.

Lego Club—Ages 5 and Up (Strict, due to small parts) We provide the blocks, you provide the creativity. Children under age 10 must remain accompanied by an adult.

Minecraft Builders Guild—If you DIG Minecraft, come play with us in the Children's Library! This program is for ages 5-12, Children under 10 must remain accompanied by an adult.

Movies at the Library– The public is invited to our listed film showings. We play the movies on the big screen in the upstairs Meeting Room. Attendees are welcome to bring their own snacks and beverages. The library will provide refreshments on occasion.
