Ruff Ruffman—Special guests from WCTE will be here to lead a fun hands on activity based on the PBS Kids show, Ruff Ruffman! Recommended ages 3-5yrs.

Sprouting Yogis Yoga— Certified yoga instructor and owner of Sprouting Yogis, Laura Burgin, will lead a child friendly yoga session, focusing on visualization, breathing, and stretching. Ages 3-7 10am / Ages 8-12 1pm.

Story & STEM—Story time followed by a hands on STEM activity! Recommended ages 3+

Advanced Readers Ages Entering 2nd Grade– Completed 6th Grade



Advanced Readers should read at least 20 minutes per day. On your reading log, write at least one sentence about what you read— what you liked, didn’t like, or something you learned. Complete this once per week, and bring it back for a new log and a prize!
