

Underwater Scene

This is a simple coloring activity, with a surprise, fun ending!

Supplies:

- crayons or markers
- clean white paper
- bubble solution
- blue paint (finger paints or tempera paint work well)

Instructions:

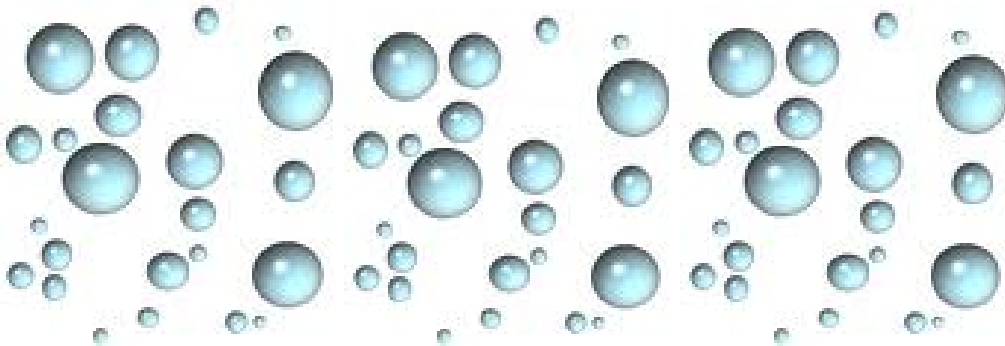
Cover work area with plastic or a few layers of newspaper.

On the white paper, have the child draw an underwater scene. They don't need to draw the actual water.

Fill a small cup with bubble solution.

Mix in a few drops of blue paint. (Make sure it is mixed well!)

Using the bubble wand, have the children blow bubbles toward the paper. The bubbles will pop once they hit the paper, and create a water effect.



This craft is fun to do outside on a calm day.

Fasten the drawing to a tree or building, and blow bubbles straight at the page, instead of down toward a table.
